COURSE DESCRIPTION

With blockchain and cryptocurrencies on the rise this course explains the underlying mechanisms. In order to understand the working we breakdown the digital ledger technology into its hashes and blocks before chaining them together. Then we compare Bitcoin to other cryptocurrencies. Finally, we actually setup a cryptocurrency wallet on a mobile device and transfer funds from one party to another.

On this course, participants begin to engage into the new world of cryptocurrencies.
